On Tuesday we will get to the Bohemian Moravian mountains, again wonderful nature and interesting places with Protestant and Jewish culture. Here we will stay overnight in this rural area with a special atmosphere.

Wednesday, July 19 and Thursday, July 20

We will continue to Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic with its very old center and its famous castle over the Vltava river. Here we will visit places of the Bohemian reformation like the medieval St. Martin Church and the Old Town square and the Headquarters of the ECCB.

Here our program will end and you can get directly back home or stay some more time in the Czech Republic with your own program.
